Tournament Information

OVERVIEW

The Millbrook Masters, now in its 8th year, is one of the most eagerly awaited amateur Master's events attracting golfers of all ages, from New Zealand, Australia, Europe and the Pacific Islands. With a renewed programme of social activities it is expected that the 2010 tournament will sell out within weeks of its release – as it has done in the past.

Its popularity is attributed to many aspects including the magic of Millbrook and the popular Masters concept. The Masters is social golf, playing 4 stableford rounds over 5 days with players of your own age group. But beware, it's hugely competitive as well. Featuring again in 2010 will be the food and wine matching lunches and a special opening dinner sponsored by Rockburn Wines who have had a long association with The Millbrook Masters. This is in addition to our regular features including a souvenir tournament jersey, welcome cocktails and dinner, mid-week mystery night and final night dinner and prize giving. It's a fun week of golf – all culminating in a special final night of entertainment, an extensive prize table and lucky draws. It's a golf tournament not to be missed.

PROGRAMME

The tournament starts with a champagne cocktail and welcome dinner on Saturday 17th April. Golf is scheduled for Sunday 18th and Monday 19th with food and wine matching lunches included and daily prize giving after play. Tuesday 20th is the rest day where you can choose to play at The Hills (home of the New Zealand Golf Open) or Jacks Point. The programme on Tuesday night will have a mystery theme this year. There are 2 more days of golf on Wednesday 21st and Thursday 22nd. The tournament winds up on Thursday 22nd, after a 'huge' night of prize giving, banquet dinner, more Rockburn Wine and entertainment!

VENUE

To our Millbrook Masters regulars The Millbrook Resort will become a 27-hole course in 2010 and we will get the opportunity to play on these new holes. The golf is New Zealand at its best! Millbrook is set in a natural, alpine amphitheatre, against the backdrop of the Remarkables mountain range. The golf course fully exploits the dramatic terrain, delivering a world-class golf championship course designed by renowned professional and master golfer, Sir Bob Charles. The new nine holes have been designed by Greg Turner. It features 4 different tee levels for complete golf enjoyment.

Millbrook Resort is located in the heart of New Zealand's tourism mecca, Queenstown. It is simply stunning. The tournament, held every year in April, captures all the magic of the region with its warm autumn colours and challenging resort golf course. In the 1860s, brothers John and Peter Butel from Normandy, France established a 450-acre wheat farm to feed hungry miners. The rustic remains of the farm live on in Millbrook's restored buildings and the avenue of trees that still welcomes visitors just as it did 150 years ago.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The Millbrook Masters has 5 divisions – 3 x men's and 2 x women's, split by age, 35-55, and 56 plus. Handicaps range from single figures to 36! Golfers compete daily for the coveted Masters trophies, in 4 rounds of stableford golf. Prizes are also awarded for the best aggregate gross – men's and women's divisions. In addition to the overall and daily prizes there are many daily draws, longest drives, closest to the pins ... the list goes on with a special lucky prize draw sponsored by Montblanc!

Tournament Conditions

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. The 2010 Millbrook Masters Golf Championship ("the Championship") shall be under the management and control of the PaR nz Tournament Committee whose decision on all matters relating to the Championship shall be final.
2. The Championship will be a 72 hole single stableford event. 'A' Grade golfers will also be eligible to compete for a 72 hole 'Gross' event. The four 18 hole Competition Rounds will be conducted on Sunday 18th, Monday 19th, Wednesday 21st and Thursday 22nd April 2010.
3. In the event that weather conditions prevent all the players from finishing their round, that Competition Round will be cancelled and the Championship reduced accordingly. Likewise should weather result in rounds one or two being cancelled the committee will consider using the lay-day as an alternative.
4. The event age categories for both men and women will be: 35 - 55 / 56 +. Handicap divisions may be added to each age division depending on the number of entries received. Note: Players must be within the appropriate age category as at the first day of play – Sunday 18th April 2010.
5. Competitors must have an official handicap and international players must present at tournament registration a current handicap card, signed by an authorised club official. All handicaps will be frozen for the duration of the tournament. Maximum handicap for women is 40.4 and men 36.4. The committee will adjust handicaps for competitors from other countries not using the USGA Slope System for handicapping.
6. Trophies / prizes for the 72 hole stableford event will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place-getters in each age / handicap division. Winners are determined by the highest aggregate of Stableford points over the four Competition Rounds. Trophies will also be awarded to the winners of the 72 hole 'A' Grade single stroke 'Gross' event in both a mens and womens division. Players may only win one trophy. Daily winners will also be announced in all divisions – players winning a prize on any day, will be ineligible for further daily prizes.
7. The event format will be morning starts on all days, unless weather delays any start. A separate draw for playing partners will be conducted for each round.
8. All events will be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf and such Local Rules as approved by the Tournament Committee.
9. All prizes will be distributed in accordance with the rules of Amateur Golf Status.
10. PaR nz Corporate Events Limited may arrange media promotion and publicity before, during and after the Championship. Competitors assent to references to them and pictures of them appearing and being used for purposes determined by PaR nz Corporate Events Limited.
11. The Tournament Committee may at its discretion amend or add any condition of the Championship.
12. All competitors participate in The Millbrook Masters Golf Championship at their own risk; the Tournament Committee, PaR nz Corporate Events Ltd, sponsors, host golf clubs and other suppliers of goods or services accept no liability for any death, injury, property loss or damage incurred during or arising out of any aspect of the conduct of the Championship.
13. An official program, and any specific details, will be sent approximately 10 days prior to the start of the event. Please supply alternate address if required.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Bookings not accepted without a completed entry form and the required deposit. Any variation to your booking must be in writing. Prices are based on tariffs and fares at the time of printing. If we are forced to change your booking and fares, then PaR nz resume the right to alter the tour / tournament price. PaR nz reserve the right to change golf courses and hotel venues to that which is advertised providing a replacement of a similar standard is substituted. In the unlikely event that you cancel, PaR nz will discuss alternative arrangements with you. Cancellation fees apply if an alternative tour cannot be substituted. More than 60 days out, \$100 administration fee applies. Inside 60 days up to 100% of the fees and refunds will be based on the basis of the amount we are able to recover from suppliers made on your behalf and / or where a replacement player cannot be found to take your place, less any costs incurred.
